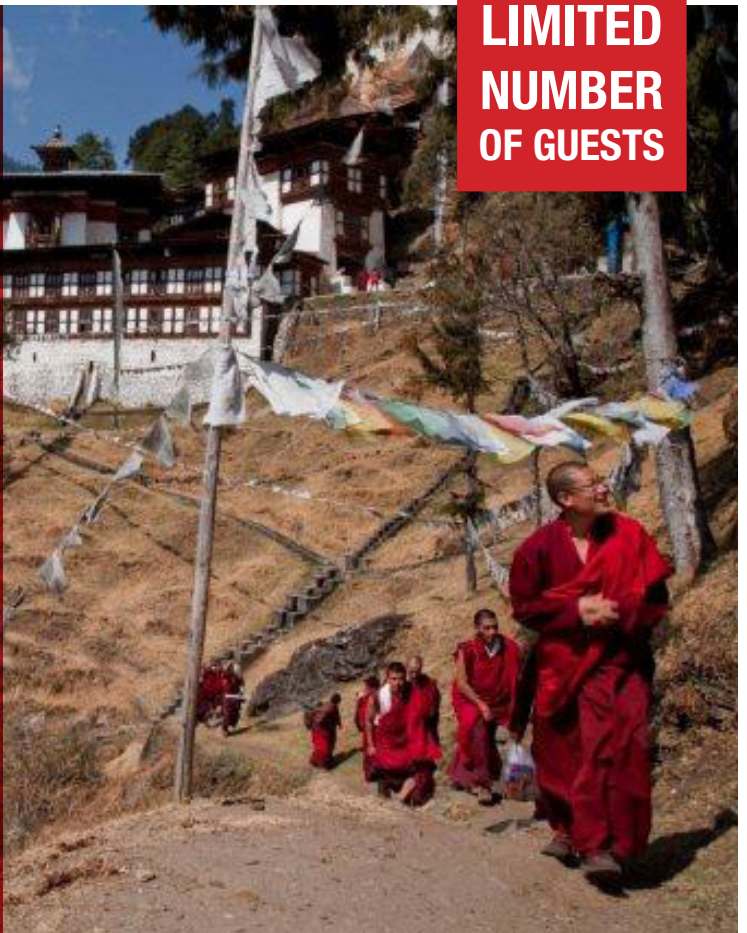

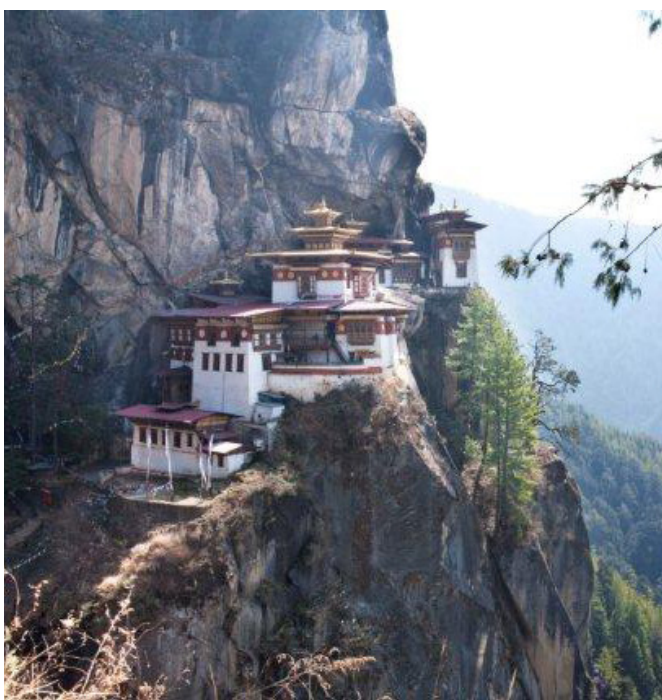

**B**hutan is an amazing country, wedged between China and India, high up in the Himalayan Range and home to thousands of the world's species. Many that we take for granted are indigenous. After leaving Bangkok at dawn on October 17 we fly past Mount Everest and other iconic, snow-covered peaks, before we land in Paro airport. We then descend to the capital, Thimpu, to allow us to acclimatise to the altitude. We walk

through pristine valley, travel over Dochula Pass, visit wonderful temples like Punaka Tzong; trek through the Phobjikha Valley, where the revered black-necked crane nests in winter. The protection of this bird is so important that electric power is shunned in the valley. On our second last day, we climb to sacred Tiger's Nest, which clings to the cliffside at around 4,000 metres. We return to Bangkok on October 26.
